Cooks Information Sheet SCHEDULE FOR 2017

Friday, July 14th, 2017: Early Arrival for Teams

The contest area will be available for early arrival after 4PM on Friday 7/15. This will be an unattended arrival. The contest organizer will NOT be present. Teams can select any space in the contest area. See the attached map for details. There will NOT be power or water available on Friday evening. Please park in the contest field, not near the ballpark. Must mark on your entry form that you will be arriving on Friday.

Saturday, July 15th, 2017: Arrival and Prep Day

ARRIVAL Team arrival is allowed any time on Saturday, however teams are encouraged to arrive before 12:00 noon.

MEAT INSPECTION Meat inspection will begin after 10AM. Please note the inspector will also verify that you have a charged fire extinguisher, meat thermometer, food service gloves, 3 wash bins (wash, rinse, disinfect), and a container for ash removal. Proper storage of meat is required. It must be maintained below 40F or above 140F. Proper handling of food is required.

COOKS MEETING The cook's meeting will be held in the judge's tent at 5PM.

Sunday July 16th, 2017: KCBS Barbeque Contest

The contest is sanctioned by the Kansas City Barbeque Society. See the KCBS Rules and Regulations handbook for detailed information governing this competition http://www.kcbs.us/pdf/2016_rules.pdf. The event will begin with turn-in promptly at 12:00 noon. 11:00 AM Judges Meeting in the judge's tent 12:00 PM Chicken turn-in 12:30 PM Pork Ribs turn-in 1:00 PM Pork Butt/Shoulder turn-in 1:30 PM Beef Brisket turn-in 4:00 PM (Approximately) Awards outside the judge's tent **Departures allowed after awards.**

WATER Water is available for free (you must provide hoses and "y" connectors). Water pressure might be low at times due to existing infrastructure.

ELECTRICITY Electricity for light general use only. Please bring 100' of extension cord and outdoor rated power strips for your electrical hookup. Some locations could be further, so teams are encouraged to bring extra cords if they have them. Hookup of refrigerators, deep fryers, AC units and other appliances is not allowed. If you have higher electrical requirements than general lighting you must bring your own quiet run generator. The organizer's discretion will apply to what defines a quiet run generator, but if your generators is rated for over 70db at 10 feet it's probably too loud.


ICE Ice is available thru contest organizer during the day on Saturday and Sunday \$3 a bag.

TRASH Trash must be removed regularly and be deposited by each contest team in the dumpster provided, not in trash barrels placed for the use of guests. Gray water, ashes and grease must be disposed in designated collection areas and should not be dumped in cook sites.

TOILETS Porta-potties will be provided for contest teams.
